QUALIFICATIONS TO ENTER

Player must have played a minimum of four matches over a minimum of four weeks in one session of any pool league sanctioned by the ACS or CCS (Canada) since 6/1/23. (ADVANCED/MASTER PLAYER = ACS, BCAPL, VNEA National Advanced/Master, any State Advanced/Master from any state list, incl. any ACS State Association, ISPA, IOMA, BCAPL, Midwest, & VNEA state lists from any other states/ or "Known Ability"). Fargo guidelines: <525-Male/ <425-Female=Standard; <625 Male/ <525 Female=Open; <674 Male/ <599 Female=Advanced; <720 Male/ <630 Female=Master +720 Male +630 Female=PRO (not eligible) **CREDIBLE AND VERIFIABLE STATS MUST ACCOMPANY EACH ENTRY!** **MISREPRESENTATION OF STATS WILL BE GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION!!**

STANDARD DIVISIONS!!!

For these ACS Midwest 8-Ball Championships a "STANDARD" skill-level player is defined as one carrying the equivalent of a "6" average or less in a local ACS league if using the well-known "10-point scoring system" or an equivalent if other local scoring system. "Known Ability" and past documented tournament results out of the money in Open divisions of other events may be taken into account. All "Standard" entries will be vetted closely, so if a player questions his/her rating, contact ACS prior to entering.

ENTRY FEES + DOUBLE ELIMINATION + WORLD-STANDARDIZED RULES + RACK YOUR OWN RACK:

- **SCOTCH DOUBLES DIVISIONS ARE JACK AND JILL TEAMS ONLY (1 MALE/1 FEMALE PER TEAM)**
- **8-BALL STANDARD SCOTCH DOUBLES-STANDARD PLAYERS ONLY—NO OPEN PLAYERS—RACE TO 3--\$100 Entry**
- **8-BALL OPEN/ADVANCED SCOTCH DOUBLES-OPEN TEAM-RACE TO 4—ADVANCE TEAM-RACE TO 5--\$100 Entry (NO MORE THAN ONE ADVANCED/MASTER PLAYER ON ADVANCED TEAM)**
- **SCOTCH DOUBLES ENTRIES MAY NOT ALSO ENTER SENIOR SINGLES DIVISION!**
- **SENIOR SINGLES ENTRIES MAY NOT ALSO ENTER SCOTCH DOUBLES DIVISION!**

Races in ALL divisions subject to change according to # of entries. There will be no scheduling conflicts between Standard/Open/Advanced Singles, Scotch Doubles and Team divisions. **OPEN TABLES! \$25 greens fee deducted from each Scotch Doubles team entry. Scotch Doubles is scheduled to be completed on Wednesday, January 17.**

TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE:

Wednesday, January 17 10:00 am Start: 8-Ball Scotch Doubles (man/woman/ Double Elimination - Finish on Wednesday!) and Men's/Mixed & Women's Senior 8-Ball Singles (Double Elimination - Finish on Wednesday!) – Attendees must choose // may **NOT** enter both Senior Singles and Scotch Doubles!

EQUIPMENT

Eighty (80) – safely separated -7-foot Pool Tables.

DRESS CODE: Sleeved shirts of polo/golf-style, tuxedo style or button-down style with a conventional fold-over collar, are required. T-shirts and sweatshirts are not allowed. Players may wear conventional-style hats. Hats/Visors/Caps are allowed with the bill facing forward. No knit hats, stocking caps, or any other headgear. Ear buds, cell phones, etc. are not permitted. Men must wear long pants or neat, clean, untorn jeans. Warm-up suits and jogging suits are not allowed. Women may wear dress pants, Capri-style pants, or neat, clean, untorn jeans, culottes, and skirts or sleeved dresses (of conservative length). Men and women must wear clean, neat, close-toed shoes at all times. Should a player require a footwear exception for medical reasons, the player must provide a letter on official letterhead from the player's health care provider before the tournament (and keep a copy of the letter available for review by a referee at all times, if requested).

- Scotch Doubles. Matching shirts are not mandatory but preferred.
