Misrepresentation of stats or FargoRate will be grounds for disqualification.

#### **REFUNDS & DIVISION CHANGES**

Written requests ONLY will be accepted for refunds and/or division changes. Requests for refunds or changes must be in the ACS office (either by mail or fax) not later than Monday, November 2, 2020. Written requests after that date cannot be considered, as the prize fund has been finalized. All refunds will be charge a \$10 handling fee. All refunds will be mailed after November 17, 2020. Side pot entry is optional and will be announced on-site. All side pot entries must be submitted prior to the start of the event.
