QUALIFICATIONS TO ENTER

Player must have played a minimum of four full matches over a minimum of four (4) weeks in one session of any pool league sanctioned by the ACS or CCS since 6/1/24. Any four players from the same league who meet these participation requirements may compose a 4-person OPEN or STANDARD team. If a team (men’s or women’s) has more than one national or state Advanced player on its roster, the team must enter the Men’s or Women’s Advanced Team division. **ADVANCED TEAMS: MAY CONSIST OF ANY QUALIFIED PLAYERS FROM ANY ACS/CCS LEAGUES (MORE THAN ONE) BASED WITHIN THE SAME STATE OR PROVINCE! (ADVANCED PLAYER = ACS, BCAPL, VNEA National Advanced or Master/ Any State Advanced/Master from any state list, incl. Any ACS State Association, ISPA, IOMA, BCAPL, Midwest, & VNEA or Advanced/Master “Known Ability”).** “TEAM ADVANCED/MASTERS” ON ANY LISTS WILL BE CONSIDERED AN “ADVANCED/MASTER” ON ANY TEAM ROSTER. Fargo guidelines: <525-Male/ <425-Female=Standard; <625 Male/ <525 Female=Open; <720 Male/ <630 Female=Adv/Master; +720 Male +630 Female=PRO (not eligible) **CREDIBLE AND VERIFIABLE STATS MUST ACCOMPANY EACH ENTRY! MISREPRESENTATION OF STATS WILL BE GROUNDS FOR DISQUALIFICATION!!**

STANDARD DIVISION GUIDELINES!!!

For these ACS Midwest 8-Ball Championships a “STANDARD” skill-level player is defined as one carrying the equivalent of a “6” average or less in a local ACS league if using the well-known “10-point scoring system” or an equivalent if other local scoring system. “Known Ability” and past documented tournament results out of the money in Open divisions of other events may be taken into account. All “Standard” entries will be vetted closely, so if a player questions his/her rating, contact ACS prior to entering.

PROFESSIONAL GUIDELINES!!!

Professional-rated players are ineligible to compete in ACS-produced events. The ACS will recognize as “professional-rated” 1). those players already listed as “Professional” on the ACS ratings list; 2). any female player Fargo-rated over 630 or male player Fargo-rated over 720; 3). or any player adjudged by the ACS tournament committee to be “Professional” from “Known Ability (KA).” Players may contact ACS to lobby to be downgraded if they can show justifiable reasons. “Fargo rating” is only one of many resources ACS uses in determining the skill level of a player.”

- **8-BALL SCOTCH DOUBLES:** Any man/woman team who meet singles entry qualifications. // \$500 Added // TWO DIVISIONS// Standard Division (no open players) Race to 3--\$80 Entry // Open/Advanced Division-Open Team (no advanced players) Race to 3; Advanced team (only 1 advanced player per team) Race to 4--Entry: \$100 // may NOT enter both Senior Singles and Scotch Doubles!
- **WOMEN’S STANDARD SINGLES:** Race to 3 // \$60 Entry Fee
- **MIXED STANDARD SINGLES:** Race to 4 // \$60 Entry Fee
- **WOMEN’S OPEN SINGLES:** \$500 Added // Race to 3 // \$100 Entry Fee
- **MIXED OPEN SINGLES:** \$500 Added // Race to 4 // \$100 Entry Fee
- **WOMEN’S ADVANCED SINGLES:** ****\$2,000 Added**** // Race to 5 // \$140 Entry Fee

- **WOMEN’S 9-BALL SINGLES:** \$250 Added // Race to 3 (Standard) / Race to 4 (Open) / 5 (Advanced) / 6 (Master) // Single or Double Elimination // **\$40 Entry paid onsite.**
- **WOMEN’S ADVANCED TEAMS:** ****\$5,000 Added**** // \$275 ENTRY FEE // Teams with two (2) or more Singles or Team Advanced players on the roster // Race to 11
- **WOMEN’S OPEN TEAMS:** \$2,000 Added // \$200 ENTRY FEE // Race to 9 maximum of 1 Singles or Team Advanced-status player on the roster
- **WOMEN’S STANDARD TEAMS:** \$150 ENTRY FEE // Race to 9 maximum of 1 Open-status player on the roster [NO Singles or Team Advanced Players allowed on a Standard Team]

- **WOMEN'S TEAMS - 2nd Chance:** \$500 Added // Race to 9/7/6 Single Elimination / Only open to teams that did not cash in main team events / **\$40 Entry paid onsite.**
- **MIXED ADVANCED TEAMS:** ****\$5,000 Added**** // \$275 ENTRY FEE // Teams with two (2) or more Singles or Team Advanced players on the roster // Race to 11
- **MIXED OPEN TEAMS:** \$3,000 Added // \$200 ENTRY FEE // Teams with maximum of 1 Singles or Team Advanced-status player on the roster Race to 11
- **MIXED STANDARD TEAMS:** \$150 ENTRY FEE // Teams with maximum of 1 Open-status player on the roster / Race to 9 [NO Singles or Team Advanced Players allowed on a Standard Team]
- **MIXED TEAMS - 2nd Chance:** \$500 Added // Race to 11/9/7 Single Elimination / Only open to teams that did not cash in main team events // **\$40 Entry paid onsite.**

Races in ALL divisions subject to change according to # of entries. Scotch Doubles and Senior events do occur on the same date at the same time. Players must make a choice between Scotch and Seniors. However, there will be no scheduling conflicts between Standard/Open/Advanced Singles divisions and Team divisions.

OPEN TABLES – GREENS FEES DEDUCTED: \$20 – 8-Ball Singles entry / \$20 – 8-Ball Scotch Doubles Team entry / \$60 – 8-Ball Teams entry // No greens fees deducted from Second Chance and 9-Ball Singles events!

Admin fee of \$5 will be deducted from each singles and scotch entry fee, \$20 will be deducted from each team entry fee.

TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE:

Wednesday, January 15 9:00am Start: 8-Ball Scotch Doubles (man/woman/ Double Elimination - Finish on Wednesday!) and Mixed & Women's Senior 8-Ball Singles (Double Elimination - Finish on Wednesday!) – Attendees must choose // may **NOT** enter both Senior Singles and Scotch Doubles!

Thursday, January 16: 9:00 am Start – Mixed & Women's Standard & Open 8-Ball Singles (Double Elimination) – Seniors may also enter

Thursday, January 16: 3:00 pm Start – Mixed & Women's Advanced 8-Ball Singles (Double Elimination) – Seniors may also enter

Friday, January 17 9:00am Start – 9-Ball Singles (Double or single elimination based on # of entries – **Onsite \$40 Entry fee. Cannot sign up if still in the 8 ball Singles**)

Friday, January 17: 7:00 pm Start Mixed & Women's Standard, Open 8-Ball Teams (Double Elimination)

Friday, January 17: 8:00 pm Start Advanced 8 Ball Teams

Saturday, January 18: 8:00 pm Start - Mixed & Women's 2nd Chance 8-Ball Teams (Single Elimination)

Sunday, January 19: 11:00 am Start – Junior Events

DRESS CODE: Sleeved shirts of polo/golf-style, tuxedo style or button-down style with a conventional fold-over collar, are required. T-shirts and sweatshirts are not allowed. Players may wear conventional-style hats. Hats/Visors/Caps are allowed with the bill facing forward. No knit hats, stocking caps, or any other headgear. Ear buds, cell phones, etc. are not permitted. Men must wear long pants or neat, clean, untorn jeans. Warm-up suits and jogging suits are not allowed. Women may wear dress pants, Capri-style pants, or neat, clean, untorn jeans, culottes, and skirts or sleeved dresses (of conservative length). Men and women must wear clean, neat, close-toed shoes at all times. Should a player require a footwear exception for medical reasons, the player must provide a letter on official letterhead from the player's health care provider before the tournament (and keep a copy of the letter available for review by a referee at all times, if requested).

- Dress code must meet the Singles competition requirements in all divisions.
- Scotch Doubles. Matching shirts are not mandatory, but preferred.
- TEAM SHIRTS **ARE REQUIRED.** MUST BE MATCHING, COLOR, LOGO, ETC. FURTHER DRESS CODE DETAILS AT www.americancuesports.org

LATE FEES: Late fees apply December 19, 2024 thru January 1, 2025. No mail in entries after January 1, 2025. Compusport entries only after January 1, 2025. Late fees--\$15/Singles; \$15/SD team; \$60/team (4 person teams). Onsite sign up MAY OR MAY NOT be available pending scheduling. Onsite late fee--\$25/Singles; \$25/SD team; \$100/team (4 person teams).

REFUNDS & CHANGES

Written requests ONLY will be accepted for refunds and/or division changes. Requests for refunds or changes must be in the ACS office (either by mail or fax) not later than Monday, January 6, 2025. Written requests after that date cannot be considered, as the prize fund has been finalized. All refunds will be charged a \$10.00 handling fee. All refunds will be mailed after the Championships have concluded. NO EXCEPTIONS!
