Entries must be at or below the division cap at the time of entry and the team total can shift no more than 10 points over the cap, or 5 points for a player over the individual player cap of 580 for Lower Scotch, and 720 (male), 630 (female) for Upper Scotch. **Established ratings lock in October 28th.**

EVENT QUALIFICATION

Open to all ACS League Members from Wisconsin, Michigan, Minnesota, Illinois, Iowa with at least two weeks of play in and ACS-sanctioned league starting on or after June 1, 2024.

League stats must be included with entry. If you submit an online entry, please email league stats to: acswisconsin@gmail.com. Misrepresentation of sanction status or league stats will be grounds for disqualification without refund, forfeiture of any prize money earned, and potential disqualification from future ACS or DR Pool events.

DETERMINING SKILL LEVELS

Any available data will be used in determining skill levels including but not limited to: FargoRating, CompuSport Rating, league stats and/or League Operator input, past tournament performances, known ability, etc.

Players with no FargoRating or less than 200 robustness will be subjected to an increase in rating before or during tournament play which could result in a higher division placement or disqualification from events.

Misrepresentation of rating will be grounds for disqualification without refund, forfeiture of any prize money earned, and potential disqualification from future ACS or DR Pool events.

REFUNDS & DIVISION CHANGES

Requests for refunds or division changes must be sent to acswisconsin@gmail.com no later than October 28th. Refunds will be processed no later than 14 days following the completion of the event. Event admin fees will be withheld from the refunded amount.

EQUIPMENT

7' Valley tables with regular-cut Ridgeback rails, blue Championship cloth, and Aramith Red Circle cue balls.

SIDE POTS

Side pot entry is optional and will be available on-site. You can only pay for your own side pot entry and must be paid prior to your first match for that event.

DRESS CODE

Clean, neat, and untorn apparel must be worn at all times. Team shirts are encouraged but are not required.

SLOW PLAY & DELAYED MATCH PROGRESSION

Teams found to be slow playing can be put on the clock with or without their opponent's request with only the offending team put on the clock. Matches not progressing at a reasonable pace can have a game added to each team's score if it does not put either team on the hill.

SOFT BREAKING

There are no soft breaks during scotch doubles play.

GENERAL

It is always a possibility that the later matches of events may run into subsequent events and will be played around those matches.

Alternate break. Rack your own. Players must use the racks provided.

Races and format in all divisions are subject to change according to number of entries.

SCOTCH DOUBLES

No time outs or coaching allowed while either player is at the table. Any assistance (verbal or non-verbal) by a team member during their turn at the table is a foul. Partners may quietly discuss anything while not at the table.

Players on a team alternate each shot. The alternating team breaks, either team member may break.

Teams may alternate shooting rotation after each game. Failure to stay in rotation once the game has started will result in a foul. The original rotation must be restored on their next turn. Note: it is permissible to inquire as to whose shot it is at anytime without fear of a coaching foul. Any further discussion when a team member is deemed to be "at the table" will result in a foul.

When the table is turned over to the incoming team, one of the partners must immediately approach the table.
