EVENT QUALIFICATION

Open to all ACS League Member from Wisconsin, Michigan, Illinois, Iowa ACS League Members with at least two weeks of play after June 1st.

League stats must be included with entry. Misrepresentation of sanction status, league stats or rating will be grounds for disqualification without refund.

DETERMINING SKILL LEVELS

Any available data will be used in determining skill levels including but not limited to: FargoRating, CompuSport Rating, league stats, past tournament performances, known ability, etc. Players with no FargoRating or FargoRatings with low robustness will be assigned a number rating by DR Pool Promotions or ACS Nationals. DR Pool Promotions reserves the right to adjust ratings at any time before or during play.

REFUNDS & DIVISION CHANGES

Requests for refunds or division changes must be submitted to dean@drpool.net no later than the last date to enter. All refunds will be charged a \$10 handling fee and will be mailed no later than 14 days following the completion of the event.

EQUIPMENT

7' Valley tables with regular-cut Ridgeback rails, Championship cloth, and Aramith Red Circle cue balls. Players must use the racks provided

SIDE POTS

Side pot entry is optional and will be available on-site. All side pot entries must be paid by your team and prior to your first match for that event.

DRESS CODE

Clean, neat, and untorn apparel must be worn at all times. Team shirts are requested, but not required.

SLOW PLAY

Players found slow playing can be put on the clock with or without their opponent's request. Matches not progressing in a reasonable manner can have a game added to each team's score if it does not put either team on the hill.

SAFETY/SOFT BREAKING

There is no soft breaking in scotch.

GENERAL

Alternate break. Rack your own. Players must use the racks provided.

Races and format in all divisions are subject to change according to number of entries.

All team matches will be played on a minimum of two or more tables.

A team may include as many as six players on the roster. Team ratings will be comprised of the three (Women's) or four (Mixed) highest rated players on the roster. Roster additions or changes must be made prior to the start of team competition.

SCOTCH DOUBLES

No time outs or coaching allowed while either player is at the table. Any assistance (verbal or non-verbal) by a team member during their turn at the table is a foul. Partners may quietly discuss anything while not at the table.

Players on a team alternate each shot. The alternating team breaks, either team member may break.

Teams may alternate shooting rotation after each game. Failure to stay in rotation once the game has started will result in a foul. The original rotation must be restored on their next turn. Note: it is permissible to inquire as to whose shot it is at anytime without fear of a coaching foul. Any further discussion when a team member is deemed to be "at the table" will result in a foul.

When the table is turned over to the incoming team, one of the partners must immediately approach the table.
