### **DETERMINING SKILL LEVELS**

Any available data will be used in determining skill levels. Players with no FargoRate or low robustness will be assigned a rating by ACS based on all available data, such as league stats, known ability, and past performances, etc. **League stats MUST be included with your entry form(s).** Misrepresentation of stats or FargoRate will be grounds for disqualification.

### **REFUNDS & DIVISION CHANGES**

Written requests ONLY will be accepted for refunds and/or division changes. Requests for refunds or changes must be in the ACS office (either by mail or fax) not later than Monday, November 2, 2020. Written requests after that date cannot be considered, as the prize fund has been finalized. All refunds will be charge a \$10 handling fee. All refunds will be mailed after November 17, 2020. NO EXCEPTIONS!

### **EQUIPMENT**

7' Valley tables with regular-cut Ridgeback rails, Championship cloth, and Aramith Red Circle cue balls.

### **SIDE POTS**

Side pot entry is optional and will be announced on-site. All side pot entries must be submitted prior to the start of the event.

### **DRESS CODE**

Clean, neat, untorn apparel must be worn at all times. Team shirts are requested, but not required.

### **GENERAL**

Rack your own, alternate break

Races and format in all divisions are subject to change according to number of entries.

All team matches will be played on a minimum of two tables.

A team may include as many as six eligible players on the roster. Additions or changes to the roster may be made after team competition begins if Tournament Director can approve and properly rate a new player.

### **SCOTCH DOUBLES**

Players on a team alternate each shot. The alternating team breaks, either team member may break.

Teams may alternate shooting rotation after each game. Failure to stay in rotation once the game has started will result in a foul. The original rotation must be restored on their next turn. Note It is permissible to inquire as to whose shot it is at anytime without fear of a coaching foul. Any further discussion when the team is deemed to be "at the table" will result in a foul.

NO COACHING: When a team is not "at the table", they may quietly discuss anything they please... or not. No time outs or coaching allowed.

Any assistance (verbal or non-verbal) by a team during their turn at the table is a foul.

When the table is turned over to the incoming team, one of the partners must immediately approach the table.
